

REGULATORY COSTS PER YEAR:

Statewide (total)

\$ 30,566

On-farm (average)

\$ 3,026

LOST REVENUE PER YEAR:

Thwarted expansion attempts

\$ 0

Lost market sales

\$ 22,000

Reduced production

\$ 58,000



Regulations substantially increased on-farm costs and constrained the industry's ability to meet market demand.
